**LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT**

*Dear Friends of St. Vincent de Paul:*

The extended economic downturn has severely impacted our community with high unemployment, foreclosures, homelessness, hunger, and healthcare deficiencies. With high energy and deep compassion St. Vincent de Paul continues working to help mitigate these problems. We were the safety net for thousands of our neighbors in Contra Costa County.

In 2011-12, the Society helped over 141,000 people. The Svdp-Loaves and Fishes Dining Room served 30,000 meals. The RotaCare Pittsburg Free Medical Clinic at St. Vincent de Paul had 1,300 patient visits. Our partnership with Winter Nights Daytime Shelter hosted 1,100 guests and our partner Catholic Charities provided Case Management for over one hundred families.

In 2012 the Council also started a Workforce Development Program, assisting people trying to return to productive lives from incarceration, drug rehabilitation or homelessness. It is a comprehensive 24-week program including hard and soft skill training. Our goal? People employed!

The caring and generosity of our Vincentian volunteers, donors, supporters and staff helped to bring comfort to the troubled, food to the hungry, and hope to the disheartened. We thank you for the difference you are making through your prayers, contributions, estate planning, volunteering, and hard work.

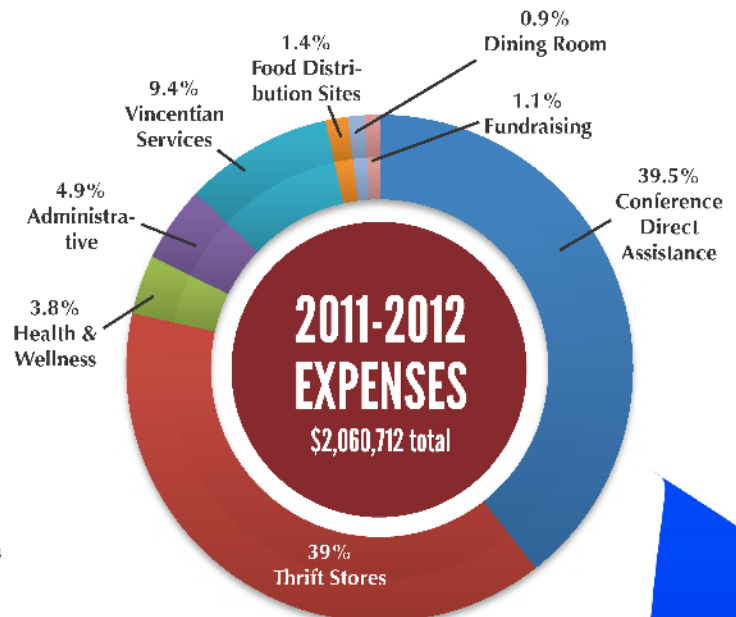
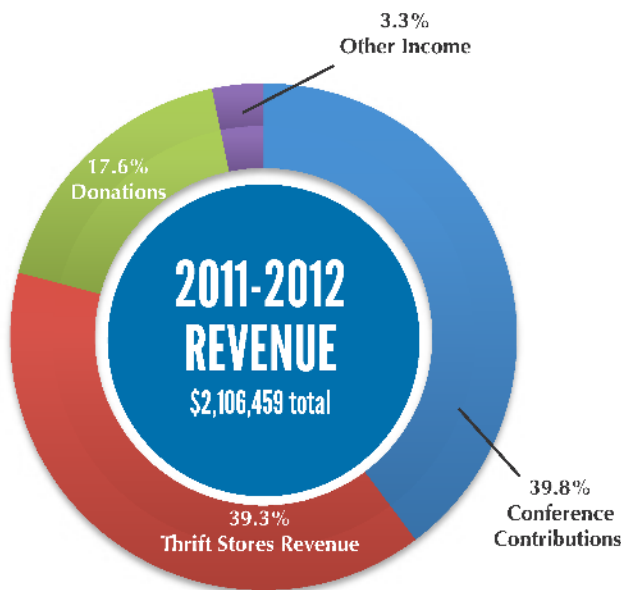


### ABOUT ALEJANDRO FLORES
