The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP), an international organization devoted to serving the poor, was founded in Paris in 1833 by a young French student, Frederick Ozanam. Founded locally in 1964, SVdP of Contra Costa serves the needy in Contra Costa County through its branches, social services and thrift stores.

• Our Volunteers

Our network of more than 900 volunteers, known as Vincentians, are key to the success of SVdP in providing help to people in their local communities. Our volunteers also work at our Family Resource Center in Pittsburg and our thrift stores.

Our thrift stores provide free and low-cost clothing, housewares, and furniture to people in need. Revenues from our stores provide earned income to support our safety net programs.

How We Help

SVdP hosts a range of programs to serve our community members in need at our Family Resource Center, 2210 Gladstone Dr., Pittsburg, and local assistance through 27 branches throughout the county.

Food Pantry

SVdP collaborates with the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano, supermarkets and other donors to provide emergency groceries to individuals and families in need. Our neighborhood-based branches operate 18 community food pantries throughout the county.



Housing & Utility Assistance

SVdP keeps our neighbors in their homes via housing and utility assistance and working with them to devise a plan moving forward.

The RotaCare Pittsburg Free Medical Clinic at St. Vincent de Paul

SVdP collaborates with RotaCare Bay Area to provide quality medical care to uninsured adults with acute or chronic medical conditions. Patients receive free medical care from volunteer medical providers.

Loaves and Fishes of Contra Costa Dining Room at St. Vincent de Paul

Free lunch served 7 days a week, made available through Loaves and Fishes of Contra Costa in collaboration with SVdP at the SVdP Family Resource Center in Pittsburg.

Workforce Development

The Workforce Development program gives training & work experience to those experiencing barriers to employment.

Daytime Shelter

Recognizing a growing need for respite during the day, SVdP collaborates with Winter Nights Family Shelter to provide a daytime shelter with private showers, Wi-Fi access and a play area/library for children.

The Dentists on Wheels Pittsburg Free Dental Clinic at St. Vincent de Paul

SVdP collaborates with Dentists on Wheels to deliver adult dental care for the uninsured, providing access to dental exams, x-rays, root canals and more!

Hot Shower Program

SVdP collaborates with The Bay Compassion, New Destiny Church, The City of Pittsburg, and Loaves and Fishes of Contra Costa to provide free, hot showers, a hot meal, and clothing to those in need every Saturday at the Family Resource Center in Pittsburg.
